.....Your Kind Attention Please.....

The National Joint Council Action has decided to call upon all Federations of Central Government Employees to organise a Massive Protest Demonstration in front of all work spots/Offices on 19th November 2015 by wearing black badges to register our anger and resentment over the Government's action in engineering delay in submission of the report by the 7th Central Pay Commission. The leaders of the National Joint Council Action will sit on a Day Long Dharna on 19th November to highlight and protest the anti-employee attitude of the present Government and its concerted efforts for undermining the grievance redressal Machinery of JCM.

The Confederation of Central Government Employees, Railway Federations, Defence Federations are in the process of mobilising their cadres to make this agitation programme a success and to highlight our demands.

They have sought the cooperation from the Confederation of Central Government Gazetted Officers Organizations.

We are not having any second opinion in extending our solidarity by mobilising our officers available in and around Delhi and we would participate in the rally on 19th November. No doubt, it is very difficult in the festive days. But the condition prevailing in the country in respect of 7th Central Pay Commission warrants no delay.

Concerted efforts are put in by the vested interests, by spreading rumours across the country through social media to undermine our legitimate scientific and justified demands for minimum wage of Rs.26000 and the date

of effect from at least 01.01.2014, Bonus to all, Interim relief, DA Merger etc. Capping this, the DoPT has issued orders for compulsory retirement by invoking Rule 56 J.

Nowadays, so many articles appear in the media against us and they are deliberately creating public opinion against our presumptive wage structure. In this situation, we have no other option but to bring our ranks closer in order to protect our existing rights.

Hence it is humbly appealed to all affiliates of CCGGOO to come forward and protest against the deliberate attempt by the Government in engineering delay in submission of the 7th Central Pay Commission by registering our resentment.

All affiliates are requested to organise a protest demonstration during lunch hour in the centrally located central Government offices under the banner of CCGGOO in the Field level wherever possible.

In Delhi all affiliates of CCGGOO are requested to extend their full hearted support by mobilising their members available in and around Delhi to join the rally on 19th November at Jantar Mantar.

It is further requested that the affiliated Associations/Federations to give necessary instruction to organize meetings on the indicated places on the scheduled date.
